# **Reservation Policy**

MIC Arts & Science College was established in 2007 with the mission to nurture a Centre of Excellence for higher education, particularly in a backward area, to empower students from marginalized sections of society. The college, recognized by the Government of Kerala and affiliated to University of Calicut since 2012, offers nine undergraduate and three postgraduate programs. It is also ISO 9001:2015 certified for quality management.

#### Admission Procedure:

The college follows a Centralized Admission Process (CAP) for both UG and PG programs as prescribed by the University of Calicut.

# 1. Online Registration:

Candidates must register online under the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) at <u>University of Calicut Admission Portal</u>. Online registration is compulsory for both UG and PG admissions.

For **Management Quota Admissions**, candidates should apply online with their **CAP ID** through the **college's application form**.

# 2. Application Process:

- o The application form can be accessed from the **college website**. Separate forms are required for **UG** and **PG** programs.
- Attested copies of mark lists from qualifying examinations must be submitted with the application.
- Candidates must provide a CAP printout and allotment memo at the time of admission.
- o Admission is confirmed only after an interview. and the parent/guardian must be present.

#### 3. **Documents Required for Admission:**

- Application Form
- Admit Card (for Merit Seat)
- CAP Registration Form (College Copy)
- o Mandatory Fee Challan
- Qualifying Certificates: SSLC, +2, Higher Secondary, Degree (Original + 3 copies)
- Transfer Certificate (TC) from the institution last attended (Original + 3 copies)
- Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended
- Genuine Certificate (if applicable, e.g., NIOS)
- Equivalency Certificate (For candidates from other states/NIOS)
- Migration Certificate (For CBSE or other than Kerala HSE)
- Recent Passport-size Photographs (3 copies)
- Community/Income Certificate (for Merit Reservation Seat)
- Certificates for NSS, NCC, Arts, Sports, dependents of Ex-Servicemen, Freedom Fighters, etc.
- Certificates proving **physical disabilities** (if applicable).
