Professional graduates will be considered, if they secure 60% marks in overall subjects
<b>M.A. POLITICAL SCIENCE</b>	Under Mark System – BA Degree in Political Science (Main), or any other Degree with at least one main paper (BA Public Administration, BA West Asian Studies) or complementary/ subsidiary paper in Political Science with 45% marks. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.



# ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission to the Merit Quota (50%) is through the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) of Calicut University. The remaining 50% seats in all the courses will be filled under Management Quota. Application form for admission under Management Quota is available in the college office. The selected candidates will be called for interview. Parents/guardians should accompany their wards at the time of interview. The following documents in original should be produced at the time of interview:

1. College copy of the CAP registration of the University of Calicut
2. Receipt of the Mandatory Fee paid to the University of Calicut
3. Mark list of Plus 2 (Original + 2 Copies)
4. SSLC or equivalent certificate (Original + 2 Copy)
5. Transfer Certificate & Conduct Certificate (Original)
6. Equivalency Certificate & Migration Certificate (for students from outside Kerala / NIOS)
7. Nativity, Community, EWS and Income Certificate (for reservation seat)
8. Medical Board Certificate (for physically challenged candidates)
9. Sports & Games Certificate (for admission under sports quota)
10. Certificates for Bonus/Weightage marks
11. Three copies of recent Passport Size Photograph
12. Qualifying Degree Certificates & Mark Lists for P.G. admission (Original + 2 Copies)
13. Copy of the University registration & Hall Ticket of Entrance Examination (M.A. Journalism and Mass Communication)

Candidates from universities other than University of Calicut are required to produce the following:

- Migration Certificate Eligibility
- Equivalency Certificate from the University of Calicut
- Qualifying Degree Certificate for P.G. admission
